SAFETY DURING FIREWORKS



1) Never give fireworks to small children, and never throw or point fireworks toward people, animals, vehicles, structures or flammable materials. Always follow the instructions on the packaging.

- 2) Keep a supply of water close by as a precaution.
- 3) Make sure the person lighting fireworks always wears eye protection.
- 4) Light only one firework at a time and never attempt to relight "a dud."
- 5) Store fireworks in a cool, dry place away from children and pets.

More pets go missing on the 4th of July after fireworks than any other day of the year. Only a small percentage of them ever make their way back home. Plan ahead to keep your pet safe! Keep them at home in a safe, comfortable, escape proof place.
