Did you know that on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 1961, the 87<sup>th</sup> United States Congress passed a joint resolution requesting that the President of the United States proclaim the third week of March National Poison Prevention Week? On February 7, 1962, President John F. Kennedy responded to this request and proclaimed the third week of March as National Poison Prevention Week. The first National Poison Prevention Week was therefore observed in March 1962. This year it is March 15<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>. Please help us teach children about poison dangers.
