LETTER OF THE WEEK

SCHOOL BACKPACK

Every child must bring a backpack everyday with his/her name on it. Please make sure the folder you were given at policy time is inside your child's bag every day. We will put any notices, calendars/newsletters, homework, etc. in this folder for your child to bring home. Please feel free to send notes and tuition inside the folder back to us as well. All correspondence should be in writing rather than simply relying on verbal conversations with the teachers at pick up and drop off times.

Each child will have a turn to be "featured" and during this time they will receive this bag. Our first "featured" child will begin on Sept. 23rd. REQUIRED FORMS

If you haven't turned in all of your forms, please do so! All of these forms are required in order for your child to attend. This includes the health care summary along with immunizations.

Please bring in family photos so we can put together a picture board of all of our preschool families. (Pet pictures are welcome also! They are part of the family too!)

TUITION

Remember tuition is due the 15th of every month for the next month's tuition. If it is not paid by the 15th there is a \$20.00 late fee charged. Put the 15th on your home calendar! We accept the following types of payment: cash, checks, Visa and MasterCard (with an additional \$5.00 charge for cards). You may also mail your payments to us postmarked by the 15th.
