If you would like your 2023 tuition statement, you can easily view and print it from Procare yourself. Just log into your Procare app and click on "Payments" in the left-hand menu. From there, you'll see a page that lists your invoices and payments. The button for pulling a PDF statement is circled in red above. This will give you a date range to choose from, going up to a 12-month period. After selecting your desired date range, press "View." From there, a PDF will appear on your browser, which you can then download and print out as needed.
